Subject: Additional Purchase Order Requirements


Dear MRAS Supplier:

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that, effective immediately Middle River Aircraft Systems (MRAS) will discontinue the use of "PR279 - Middle River Aircraft Systems General Provisions for Purchase" on all **NEW** Request for Quotations (RFQ) and Purchase Orders (PO). After this date a reference to "C64 - Terms and Conditions of Purchase" as well as an MRAS Site Specific Addendum will appear on new RFQs and Purchase Orders (PO's). All PO contracts and PO amendments issued prior to April 26, 2010 will continue to conform to the requirements contained in PR279 throughout the period of performance of that contract.
